## **Rebuilding Together Grays Harbor Annual Grays Harbor Salmon Derby And Steve “Buzz” Peters Memorial Derby**

1. Derby Entry is by donation. Winners must complete and sign the entry form, but need not be in attendance at the Derby’s 5:00 pm closing time to claim prize. Entry: \$25 per person.
2. Additional tickets may be purchased at \$25 each to increase one’s chance of winning a prize in the drawing, but no contestant may win more than one CASH prize in the derby regardless of the number or size of the fish entered.
3. Fishermen must have a derby ticket prior to fishing. All derby ticket holders are eligible to fish, including derby officials. All fishermen are required to present their ticket at the weigh-in station to qualify for a derby prize. **A valid WA State Fishing license must be presented.**
4. Tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable. Ticket name must match weigh-in name. If you are unable to participate, you cannot give your ticket to someone else.
5. All Washington State fishing rules and regulations apply.
6. Derby fishing allowed on open waters within Grays Harbor County as defined by the **2007-2008 Fishing In Washington Rule Pamphlet.**
7. **Derby fish must be gutted and gilled prior to check in.** Fish must be checked in, weighed and inspected at the Derby headquarters the same day they are caught, within the following official Derby hours: Saturday, October 6, 2007 from 6:30 am until 5:00 pm and Sunday October 7, 2007 from 6:30 am until 5:00 pm..
8. The Derby official(s) logging the catch will note the time on the derby ladder at the official weigh-in station. In case of a tie, the earliest fish checked in is the winner.
9. The Derby committee shall have the final word on all disputes regarding Derby rules and awarding of prizes.
10. Contestants observing violations of the Derby rules should report immediately to derby officials. Violators will not be eligible for prizes. Derby officials may be contacted at 360-580-1433 during Derby hours.
11. The winners will be determined following the 5:00 pm closure of the Derby, Sunday, October 7, 2007 at the official weigh-in station, ILWU Union Hall, 3105 John Stevens Way. If a winner is not present, he or she will be contacted by phone immediately after the contest.
12. Anyone entering and/or providing assistance to Derby officials or contestants does so of their own free will and thereby agrees to hold the sponsors of the Derby harmless for damages or claims which may arise.
13. All prizes final at time of award.
